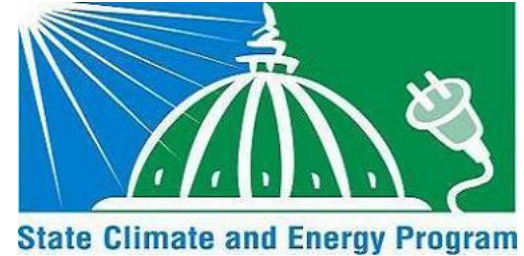

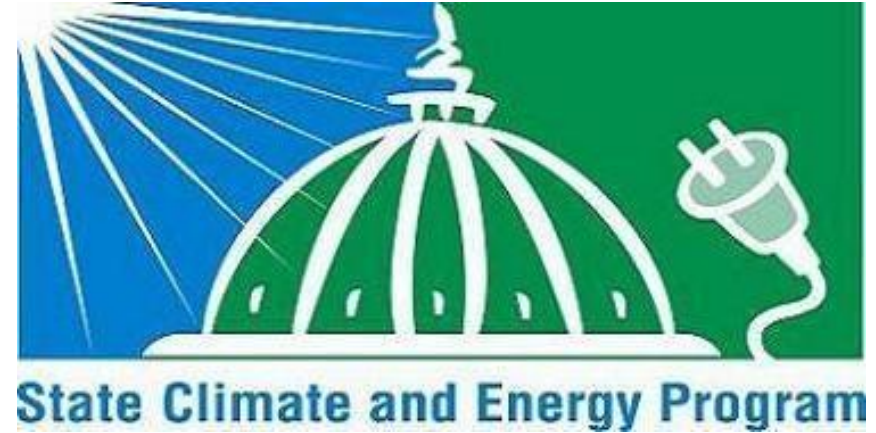

Non-Energy Benefits of End-Use Energy Efficiency

- ▶ Non-energy (or co-benefits) benefits are simply the impacts of an energy efficiency program other than energy and demand savings.
- ▶ Consumer comfort, safety and infrastructure
- ▶ Environmental benefits (e.g., avoided emissions) and Jobs
- ▶ Energy infrastructure stability and reduced investment requirements
